Make time this year for: Adelaide Nash Hash

G'Day Nash Hashers,

Hey, we managed to survive 2020 and everything the pandemic threw at us then. Let's now tackle 2021. The Committee is working hard on the assumption that Adelaide Nash Hash is going ahead from the **5th to the 7th of November 2021**. That's now less than 10 months away! COVID-19 vaccinations are due to start next month and most of us should have had a jab or two by Nash Hash. Hopefully there won't be many restrictions still in place by then, but if there are we'll try to live with them.

We've managed to shift all our previous bookings to November, including several run hubs and the main venue at the old Adelaide Gaol, at no additional cost. Any cost increases for other items will be at least partially offset by extra bank interest earned.

After our postponement announcement we had a few reshuffles of names without much change in the overall numbers. About 20 hashers advised that they can't make it in November and most of their paid regos have been bought by others. We now have 851 fully registered and paid, plus another 25 who have registered their interest but haven't yet paid.

Some of those hashers registered are yet to provide their T-Shirt size and other preferences. We will contact you again by email.

We hear that some of you are still planning to visit Adelaide in March. We'll be putting on a special Saturday run on the 20th of March, which was going to be the main run day before we postponed. Details will be advised next month, but please let us know if you are definitely coming by emailing us at info@adelaidenashhash.com.

The original offers of group accommodation booking discounts in March have all lapsed. We are still hopeful of rescheduling our booking at the Breakfree apartments but they are waiting for confirmation of an earlier group booking in November for the Ashes Test match. That event is now likely to be after Nash Hash so we should fit in. Hash clubs should pursue other group bookings on their own. It should not require prepayment - usually a code will be given for each hasher to book as long as ten rooms are booked overall.

The Saturday Cycle Hash during Nash Hash still doesn't have enough participants to justify hiring a bus and bike trailer to take you out of town, rather than a ride from the Gaol. Let us know if you want to change your Run Selection.

Are there any other bidders for Nash Hash 2023 apart from Central Coast (NSW)? As previously advised, bids close at the end of March.

All of the Pre Lube organisers have agreed to the postponement dates. We have flyers on the website for the Red Dress Run, Ladies Lunch and the 100kg Run so far, and regos are open for these. The Cycle Hash Prelube doesn't need a flyer as it's already full, but it's worth contacting Slab if you are interested in a multi-day ride before Nash Hash. We are waiting on flyers for the Men's Lunch and the Legends Lunch. Please note when paying for the Red Dress Run use "Adelaide Nash Hash" as the account name rather than "Red Dress Run".

Adelaide only has a small hashing community and hence a limited number of volunteers for Nash Hash. We are looking for interstate volunteers to act as co-Hares assisting local Hares for all the runs and for Hashes and/or Hashers to run some of the circles after the runs. We are also looking for volunteer trained first aiders for the smaller run hubs where we won't have St Johns Ambulance attending. So far we have Digit Digester from Sydney who has volunteered to help with first aid (thanks again). If you would like to volunteer for anything please email us at info@adelaidenashhash.com.

It's also not too soon to start thinking about Hash Acts to be presented on stage at Nash Hash. An act incorporating strategically placed COVID masks might work!
