

Newsletter for those coming to Adelaide in March

G'day Nash Hashers! This newsletter will tell you what will be going on while you are in Adelaide, and there's a lot - despite Adelaide Nash Hash being cancelled.

Firstly, goody bag collection while you are here. You'll have three or four opportunities to pick up your bags and maybe a few others (if you have told us whose extra bags you'll collect). The first time is from 5pm to 8.30pm on Wednesday 23 March at the Cumby hotel – 205 Waymouth St in the city CBD. You can also collect your bags on Thursday 24 March at the Cumby between midday and 3pm. The bags will be upstairs in the big Cumberland Room on both days. You'll also be able to register & pay for Saturday's Not the Nash Hash run while you are there.

The bags may also be available for collection at Olive Oil's new Adelaide Red Dress Run at the Nairobi Affair Lounge (previously the Producers Hotel) 235 Grenfell St in the city. That run starts at 6.30pm on Thursday 24 March - a flyer will be out soon.

The goody bags can also be collected at the Not the Nash Hash Run on Saturday 26 March at Belair National Park, both before & after the runs (which start at 11am).

Lastly, for those who have volunteered to pick up large numbers of bags for their club or area, a separate pick up with easy parking can be arranged at our bag storage at Regency Park on either Wednesday 23 March or Monday 28 March. PreLubes

Whilst the Ladies Lunch, the original Nash Hash Red Dress Run, the 100kg run and the Legend's Lunch were cancelled, others are still on and new ones have been added!

The Cycle Hash PreLube is still on from Sunday 20 March to Thursday 24 March.

A new event called Blip's Tram Pub Crawl is on Thursday 24 March, meeting at the Strathmore Hotel on North Terrace at 2.30pm for a 3pm start.

Olive's Adelaide Red Dress Run is on Thursday 24 March. Turn up at 6.30pm for a 7pm run start – see above for more information. A flyer will be out soon – check the website and Facebook. The cost will be \$30 pp and the charity is still Foodbank.

The HIV Piss Up bus trip to Hahndorf (in the Adelaide Hills) is on Friday 25 March. The bus leaves the city at 10am sharp, and eventually returns when you're not feeling quite so sharp!

The Men's Lunch also will be on Friday 25 March, starting at midday at a secret naughty location to be advised a week before to those who register.

Rebel Run 3, The Gaol Break Day Run, by Nomads & Delinquents H3 is also on Friday 25 March at the Gilbert Street Hotel in – wait for it – Gilbert Street in the city, starting at 3pm.

Olive is also planning a bus trip to Vineyard Road Winery in the Barossa Valley on Sunday 27 March. Again, a flyer will be out soon(ish).

Flyers so far can be found on the Nash Hash website, and some are on Facebook as well. Others will be added when received.

Adelaide Hash runs each Monday and the Adelaide Harriettes each Tuesday night, both starting around 7pm. The local runs of both hashes in the weeks before and after the Not The Nash Hash Run are likely to have a lot of visitors, so we need to plan accordingly. The Not The Nash Hash Run

Saturday 26 March 2022

- Venue – The Main Oval and Pavilion in **Belair National Park** has been hired for the day on Saturday 26 March. Belair NP is about 10 km from the Adelaide CBD in the foothills. The run venue is immediately south of the Park's main entrance road.
- Attendance – likely to be ~280 including Adelaide hashers.
- Parking – You can use the free carpark outside the caravan park (the Belair Nat'l Park Holiday Park) & avoid park entry fees – after parking go through the pedestrian gate into the Park, turn left & the venue is 100m away. The entry road to this carpark is ~100m south of the Park's main entrance. There is also a small free carpark just inside the Park main entrance – but this fills quickly. Park entry fee per vehicle is \$12 (\$10 concession) payable online if you want to park slightly closer to the venue. See map below.
- Transport for visitors not driving or getting a lift to the venue – trains run from Adelaide Railway Station on North Terrace to Belair station on Saturdays about every half hour. From Belair station you need to walk downhill for 1 km to the venue. Adelaide hasher LeftRight has volunteered to meet and direct visitors arriving by train at Belair station to the Not the Nash Hash Run venue (1km away). Buses on Saturdays from the city are only every 2 hours, but drop close to main Park entrance. An Uber X with up to 3 hashers is about \$25 each way – or less per head in an Uber XL. Or carpool with a designated driver if you have a vehicle. Or camp in the caravan park on Saturday night. Just get there! Visiting Senior Card holders can get a temporary card at the Adelaide Railway Station to use Adelaide Metro public transport for free for 14 days.
- Runs –There will be a medium run (8.5km), a short run (7km) and a walk (3.6km). All have some hill climbing involved (less so on the walk). They all stay on Park tracks, are marked with white lime arrows and they all have checks. There are no drink stops so take water on the runs. You're running at your own risk so try not to fall over!
- Cost – the run fee is \$30 each for a packed lunch and all drinks (beer, cider, wine, softies and water) plus a share of all other costs. Transport to & from the run is your responsibility. The cunning plan is that you can pay the run fee using cash or eftpos at the Cumby when collecting your bags on Wed night or Thursday afternoon, at the

Red Dress Run on Thurs night or at the run venue in Belair NP on the Saturday. When you pay you'll get a wristband which you'll need to get served at the run. Note that cunning plans don't always work perfectly!

- Bring your hash drinking vessel & hand sanitizer from your goody bag – or drink from cans
- Goody bags – your bag will hopefully be available for collection at the run if you haven't picked it up already at the Cumby.
- Seamen Feeder will be selling Hash name necklaces at the run.
- Timing – sign-ons with QR check-ins (bring your phone) and bag collection will start at ~9.30 am. The runs & walk will start at ~11am. Lunch will be from about 12.30 to 1.30 pm, followed by the circle. No Down down or wet T-shirt comps are planned (it's too public) but general drinking can continue after the circle! We plan to pack up & leave by 5pm. The Park gates shut at sunset.
- We have to take all rubbish out with us so please help by putting empty cans & bottles in their cartons & boxes, and putting other rubbish in the rubbish bags provided.
